



FEE SCHEDULE FOR 2009

The CMPA determines membership fees based on your type of work (TOW) AND where you work or train.

- TOW codes are described below.
- Fees by TOW code and fee region are listed on the reverse.

This code is not appropriate for physicians holding specialist certification who continue to perform clinical work in their specialty or for family physicians who also have a general practice. Also, this code is not appropriate for physicians eligible for code 12 or 14.	
32 Revised	Clinical Associates, Hospitalists, Hospital-based physicians, House Officers or House Medical Officers – on a surgical service . Includes assistance at surgery, pre/post-operative care (does not include labour and delivery or independent surgical practice and fracture care, CCU, ICU, NICU work or emergency department consultation for specialist services). This code is not appropriate for physicians holding specialist certification who continue to perform clinical work in their specialty or for family physicians who also have a general practice. Also, this code is not appropriate for physicians eligible for code 12 or 14.	
13* Revised	Clinical Fellows – physicians pursuing a structured program not recognized by the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC) or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC), or a provincial/territorial medical regulatory authority: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> up to 36 months of supervised training in addition to the accredited programs of the CFPC or RCPSC OR equivalent training and qualification in another country; must be based at a university-affiliated teaching hospital; includes only that clinical work integral to the additional training; includes extra resident shifts; this code will not include assistance by the CMPA in case of medico-legal difficulty arising from independent practice of medicine outside the program whether remunerated or not. <p>NO MOONLIGHTING.</p> <p><i>Clinical Fellows who moonlight must select the appropriate practising physician code, not code 14.</i></p>

FAMILY MEDICINE OR GENERAL PRACTICE	Family Medicine or General Practice (private office, CLSC, hospital or ward work, walk-in/urgent care clinic, home care, nursing home, or chronic/long-term care facility). Includes assistance at surgery. If work is restricted to one area of care, e.g., addiction medicine, geriatrics, hospital work, occupational medicine, palliative care, sport medicine, or psychotherapy, select the appropriate code from the Fee Schedule. If work is restricted to minor cosmetic procedures, choose code 37. These family practice codes are not appropriate for physicians holding specialist certification who continue to perform clinical work in their specialty.

12*	Trainees who are registered in a program of postgraduate training recognized by the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC), or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC), or a provincial/territorial medical regulatory authority. Includes extra resident shifts. This code is also used by International Medical Graduates in a program to obtain a licence for independent practice. This code will not include assistance by the CMPA in case of medico-legal difficulty arising from independent practice of medicine outside of the program whether remunerated or not. NO MOONLIGHTING.
14* Revised	Trainees who are registered in a program of postgraduate training recognized by the College of Family Physicians of Canada (CFPC), or the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada (RCPSC), or a provincial/territorial medical regulatory authority. This code will include eligibility for assistance by the CMPA in case of medico-legal difficulty arising from independent practice of medicine outside of the program whether remunerated or not. WITH MOONLIGHTING. Trainees who moonlight must hold licensure/registration acceptable to the regulatory authority (College) in the jurisdiction in which the moonlighting will occur. Those who moonlight outside the region of their program must select the fee region with the highest fee. Trainees who limit their clinical activities to only moonlighting work (e.g., locum) for more than two consecutive weeks must change to a practising physician code. Clinical Fellows (code 13) who moonlight are not eligible for code 14.

- **Trainees who moonlight outside the region of their program:** Select the fee region with the highest fee.
- **Clinical Fellows who moonlight:** Select the appropriate practising physician code and fee region where you moonlight.
